
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## ANNOUNCEMENTS...

The Caribbean Institute for Meteorology and Hydrology (CIMH) - Barbados is the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) Regional Climate Centre (RCC) for the Caribbean - Demonstration Phase ... View Agro-met bulletins around the world ... November is the last month of the Hurricane/wet Season in our area ... It is important to remain prepared!!!





Tropical waves and trough systems brought moderate to heavy showers across St. Vincent and the Grenadines on various occasions. It was a wet month, with a few landslides reported, and two occasions of flooding in the Arnos Vale area. The highest total rainfall was recorded in the Hermitage area (see figure 1). Maximum temperature recorded was in the Langley Park area (see table 1). Nighttime temperatures began cooling down around the middle of the month.

Sea-swells were generally slight to moderate in open waters. Sahara dust haze reduced visibility on a few occasions. Gusty winds during the third week were quiet noticeable. Maximum winds recorded were 31knots (57.4 km/h) in the Arnos vale area.



## **National Rainfall Outlook**


November – December – January... 40% chance normal

2m Air Temperature... normal to above normal Sea Surface Temperature...0.5 - 1.0°C above normal



November is one of the wettest months on record with 277.6mm rainfall total and 20 rain-days(using E.T. Joshua Airport 1981-2010 period average). November is the last month of our official hurricane/wet season. The formation of tropical storms in our area is still possible.
